A Note About Using Lustres:

Lusters are a low temperature, third firing overglaze. They must be applied to clean, fired work. Use rubbing alcohol to clean surface of piece before painting with lusters. Use a clean, luster dedicated brush to avoid contamination. Always work in a well ventilated area. Fire to shelf cone 019 to 018 in a well ventilated kiln. For best results you can fire with the lid slightly propped, shutting it only after the firing has finished. Once fired, lusters are not microwave safe and should be hand washed. Use Luster Essence to clean brushes.
